The Parish Council is pleased to announce that a new bus shelter on Derby Road, opposite Danesby Crescent was installed on 21<sup>st</sup> February 2019. This shelter was part funded by the Parish Council who will now take ownership of the shelter. Arrangements will be made for the shelter to be electrically connected but this can take a while as the work is programmed in with E-On.

Update - the damaged bus shelter on High Bank has been repaired.

### **New grit bin – Denby Village**

A new grit bin has been positioned next to the Parish notice board on Pippin Hill with the junction of Church Street, Denby.

The bin was provided by Derbyshire County Council grit bin scheme with the Parish Council accepting ownership/future maintenance responsibility (this includes refilling/replacement should the bin get damaged or stolen).
